As we have received a couple of mails asking for clarifications on positions etc. It is best to start here:

Please pay particular attention to rules 9 & 10 which contain the information around ties and count backs as they are separate entities for different situations.

You are only involved in a count back if you have received an e-mail notifying you of this (count backs involve a minimum of three people), the e-mail would have been detailed to the level required and overall positions are worked out on the least detailed level downwards until we can differentiate positions between the players:

If you have any questions please e-mail in but most questions can be answered by having a look at the above link; if you think we have missed something or we have a rule that doesn't quite cover something or a situation please let us know and we will take your idea and make it into a rule as I'm quite sure there will be occurrences each month that are not wholly covered and the rules like the league evolve as it faces new situations or something that we have completely overlooked.

The other main issue is the pool numbers, the pool numbers are only that; numbers. The overall ranking in the league in terms of positions are what we go by when doing the pools as everyone is in the correct pool playing the correct people. After pool 10 you will all find that you have increased your ranking by 1/3 positions because of leavers. We try and place new people into a pre arranged pool so that it has no bearing on that month's promotion and demotion and all players benefit before adding new players in so that it does not interfere with the natural progression of the league and players.

We have to do this as people leave and new people come in, if people leave them the remaining members shuffle upwards to fill in the spaces left behind.
