

Good Evening Everyone

This is our last message to each of you in respect to the league.

As you may or may not be aware we have had to go through a lot with Badminton Scotland and the Cockburn Centre over the last month or two in order to become a fully recognised league in Scotland and to keep everything above board and visible to the extent where you are now fully recognised players or not based on their criteria which we must abide by and are happy to do so. At present you are not as you have not paid your admin so we will not affiliate you to be able to play in the league as per their requirements. As we are looking to become a recognised part of circuit and competition calendar we will do everything we can in order to ensure all guidelines are adhered to!

As it is wholly unfair for the rest of the league members to subsidise your entry into what will now be a fully recognised competition circuit we have to abide by the criteria of Badminton Scotland and not allow anyone that is not a member of Badminton Scotland through affiliation of the Shuttleworks Singles League to compete in the League.

As a standalone league (we are in the process of completing all required paperwork for fully sanctioned status) that is recognised and legal we have to affiliate everyone as a member as a pre-requisite of being able to play in the Shuttleworks Singles League, the league will have restrictions imposed on it meaning that we can run a fully sanctioned restricted tournament that will be part of the programme of events calendar for season 2009/2010 but more importantly none of its members can be held in bad standing for playing in a non sanctioned tournament which is our main concern.

Thank you for participating in the league but at the end of this September (when the new season begins) we will need to remove you as you cannot participate in accordance with Badminton Scotland policy.
